**Q1** I'm going to ask you your opinion about several executives of big tech companies. Here's the first one: do you have a very favorable, somewhat favorable, somewhat unfavorable, or very unfavorable opinion of Meta CEO Mark Zuckerberg?

This would be implemented in the form of a "Big Tech tax." Would you support or oppose a tax on Big Tech companies to make them pay their fair share?

Meta's Mark Zuckerberg has changed his wardrobe and appeared on far-right podcasts echoing right-wing talking points. Critics have said these moves are attempts to curry favor with the Trump administration. **Q14** What is the highest level of education you have received: high school graduate or less, some college but did not finish, 2-year college degree, 4-year college degree, or post-graduate degree?

*High school graduate or less* ..... 17%  
*Some college but did not finish* ..... 29%  
*2-year college degree* ..... 12%  
*4-year college degree* ..... 23%  
*Post-graduate degree* ..... 19%
